From the Pen of Chairman

Jai Mahavir,

While we all associate new year with the calendar year, for many of us living in the target of financial years, April 1st symbolizes the real new year. Even the Hindu New year is known to start on the first day of Chaitra Navratri, which falls around this time. April is also the month of various festivals like Baisakhi, Bihu, gudi Padwa, Ugadi – to name a few. Closer to us is the fact that we celebrate Jayanti of Lord Mahavir on whose teachings of universal love and service our organization has been founded. So I take the liberty of wishing all our dear members and Stakeholders a very Happy New Year!

This is indeed the right time to evaluate how we have fared as an organization in terms of fulfilling our objectives and hence I will dwell on some figures.

First and foremost blessings of Goddess Lakshmi (commonly associated with wealth) is indeed very necessary for the success of any enterprise and in this context, I am happy to share that our receipts grossed over Rs. 7 Crores for the first time ever – powered mainly by CSR grants received from Corporates in general and CPSEs in particular. Of course there were also liberal contributions from our members and the enhanced donations received for the subsidized treatment services provided by our centres played a role too. Thanks to same, we were able to organize 306 camps (including 70 school camps) and conduct/sponsor 1758 cataract surgeries in the last one year. Another 111 surgeries have been performed after detection in camps organized by MID in Kota and Jaipur, which takes the overall number of beneficiaries to 1869! In all 2.5 lakh plus consultations were carried out in our centres and during course of the camps. Given the increasing workload, grants were also sought and received for procurement of various medical equipment - some of which are being passed on to our affiliate MI centres, who are sincerely partnering us in the field of health care.

What also has been all the more pleasing is the grant of new projects beyond provision of health care. MID has been sanctioned a project for recharging of ground water in parched Alwar district of Rajasthan whereby we hope to inject into mother earth lakhs of litres of rain water to enhance the water table in Kathuwas – location of the Multi Modal Logistics Park (MMLP) of CONCOR. We have been additionally sanctioned a project for upgradation of infrastructure of multiple schools and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in Cuddalore and Chennai districts in distant Tamil Nadu.

Women Empowerment has been another focus area. The Swavalamban project was carried forward with help of MI Apex, Singer and SSS Foundation with nearly 120 women undergoing course on Apparel Stitching and General Duty Assistant/Health care training. Three of the trained GDAs have been deployed as Swasthya Saheli at each of our three centres where over the last one year they have counseled close to 15000 women on sensitive issues of menstrual hygiene and breast feeding. Towards the end of the year, we were also welcome recipients of a CSR grant for organizing health counseling workshops on pre and post natal care, taken by a qualified Nursing trainer, for over 700 pregnant women and lactating mothers. While the benefits of such sessions will be experienced by the women and their families for quite some time, an immediately ascertained positive impact has been that around 30 families have gone in for family planning measures, while 18 women who were earlier planning unsafe deliveries at home, got themselves hospitalized for the same.

All in all the developments of the last one year have been a tribute to systems in place in our organization which is enhancing trust of our stakeholders. At the same time, it places even more responsibility on us to redouble our efforts for serving with love.

This being the 50th year of Mahavir International and also culmination of 45 years of MID, I conclude with an earnest request to all members and stakeholders to participate more actively in the various noble activities of our organization and sharing our compassion with our underserved brethren, which should undoubtedly hold us in good stead in our own life's journey also.

It gives me immense pleasure and satisfaction, to be able to bring smile on the gloomy faces of the large populace of disadvantaged section of the society in the year 2023-24. The year ended on 31st March 2024 was eventful as always with addition of some new activities.

To provide healthcare access to under-privileged communities MID has proudly inaugurated a new Dental Clinic facility on 9th March, 2024 at Lala Aman Singh Jain Charitable Centre, Hauz Rani Delhi.

Last year, Mahavir International Delhi started the new initiative for empowering the unemployed youth from the distressed & under privileged by commencing training programs as NURSING ASSISTANTS. I am happy to share that till 31st March 2024, 96 students have successfully completed their course.

One another project on sewing Training under initiative SWAVLAMBAN project for WOMEN EMPOWERMENT INITIATIVE of MI Apex under the wings of Vira vision was also started last year and 76 women have successfully completed this course.

MID had taken-up the project SWASTHYA SAHELI for women where a trained woman is providing counseling on menstruation and women health at the hospitals till 31st March, 2024 we are able to guide 14222 women on the menstrual hygiene and 5337 for breast feeding.

Mahavir International emphasizes the importance of early detection and correction of vision-related issues among underprivileged children, acknowledging that untreated visual impairments not only pose health risks but also disrupt their educational journey. In the past, the organization collaborated with the Delhi Government under the Chacha Nehru Sehat Yojana, conducting extensive health assessments and counseling for students. To build on these efforts, Mahavir International has reintroduced the initiative under the title Jhakhe Nanhi Aakho Mein (झांके नन्हीं आंखों में). This program focuses on organizing vision screening camps in partnership with schools operated by the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) and other NGOs, ensuring timely intervention through the provision of corrective eyewear. In the financial year 2023–24, a total of 100 camps were conducted, benefiting more than 12,598 students and facilitating the distribution of approximately 1,507 spectacles.

In F Y 2023-24, further strengthen to the women, MID launched a New Project – “जननि कार्यशाला”, aiming to educate young expectant mother about maternal and child health to minimize the risks of complications during pregnancy and childbirth. Total 24 workshops were organized, total 720 women were educated about the crucial topics including prenatal care, proper nutrition and exercise during pregnancy, safe deliver practices, postpartum care, breastfeeding, birth spacing and the advantages of small families. To all attendees of the workshops also distributed a maternity kit and nutritional kit containing essential items to support the well-being of both the mother and her new born.

A another ambitious project is also taken up by Mahavir International for recharging of ground water in Alwar district of Rajasthan, through this project we will be able to inject into mother earth lakhs of liters of rain water to increase the water level.

MID also reach in Tamil Nadu, south India to serve the needy start of the society by providing the support for installation of medical equipment's in the Govt. Primary Health Centre (PHCs) and Infrastructure facilitation for the government schools.

During the year ended on 31st March 2024 the Medical Equipment worth Rs. 1 cr. And Two New fully equipped Mobile Medical Van were added to the infrastructure of MID under CSR initiative of PETRONET LNG LTD. & IRCTC Ltd. A Navratna PSU. We are thankful to PETRONET LNG LTD & IRCTC for this magnanimous support.

MID celebrated its Foundation Day-2023 at the of SAFEXPRESS Pvt. Ltd. Gurugram on 9th July 2023 and also celebrated Eye Care Day “**Hope for Light**” on 25th Nov 2023.

I express my thanks and gratitude from the bottom of my heart to the Chairman Shri K. Narayan, Patrons, Board members, my colleagues and others for their continuous guidance and support in fulfilling my responsibilities as secretary.

In the end I express my gratitude to all donors, sponsors, philanthropists and supporters for their continued support and faith in us to achieve the cherished mission of service to the society in mitigating their hardships.

I will be failing in my duty if I do not mention the support given to me by the team of our Doctors, medical & para-medical staff, administrative staff and associated agencies and suppliers who have been working tirelessly in achieving our mission “**LOVE ALL- SERVE ALL**” and “**CATARACT FREE DELHI**” and hope that their support will continue to be forthcoming in the years to come.

Mahavir International Delhi (MID) was established in 1979 and has been engaged in social service activities since its inception.

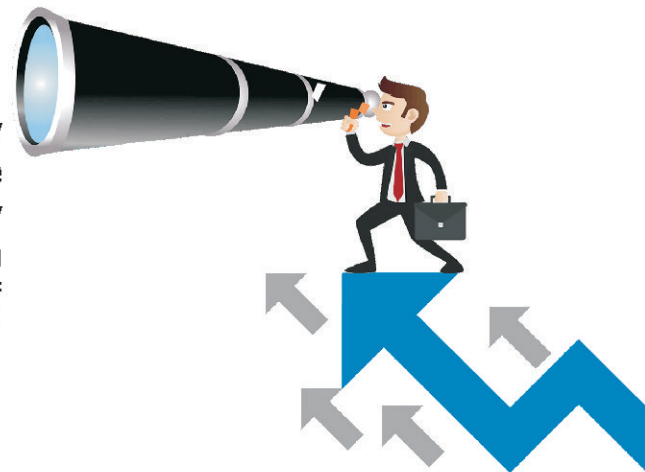
OUR VISION

Work selflessly and tirelessly towards laying the foundation of creating a healthy society with special focus on timely diagnosis of diseases to prevent their aggravation in order to improve overall health of disadvantaged sections of society while aiming for a cataract free Delhi and ultimately, the rest of India.



OUR MISSION

To expand reach and spread of health care facilities by organizing one mobile health check-up Camp a day in rural, remote and slum areas by empowering people, especially women by creating knowledge and awareness about the need for better health and hygiene through sustained publicity and prevention of diseases. Manage and operate more free or affordable medical and diagnostic centers and set up our own eye bank.



OUR MAJOR FOCUS

Mahavir International's primary focus is health care with special emphasis on Eye care. Its motto is 'Love All Serve All' and mission is to make 'Delhi Cataract Free' as the said ailment is the major cause of blindness in the country (66% as per AIIMS report of 2018). It also works towards the elimination of blindness by motivating people for "Eye Pledge" and for "Eye donation" of relatives of people after their death. We have 3 charitable hospitals in Delhi. Our focus is on quality health services for the underprivileged in the city – including daily wagers, street vendors, migrant laborers and treating their families with care, concern and compassion. OPD services are provided at nominal registration fee, along with free medicines and diagnostic tests at highly subsidized rates.



OUR OTHER SIGNIFICANT PROJECTS

1. DOCTOR AT DOOR STEP

“If patients can't reach the Doctor then Doctor must reach the Patients” - MID

Under our flagship project 'DOCTOR AT DOOR STEP', till end of this financial year, we had organized more than 3800 free check-up camps resulting in more than 16 lacs consultations including hospital patient here in health check facilities are offered either in remote locations with limited access to quality health care or at locations in and round the premises or operations of our sponsors. The services offered in these checks include consultation by general physician, ladies doctors, eye specialists, optometrists, EGC and blood tests as per need and distribution of medicines and spectacles. Those detected with cataract are thereafter facilitated free / subsidized correcton surgeries at centres of MID or our affiliates.

Acknowledging the impact of these camps in terms of taking health care to the Doorstep of the poor, various leading Business and Corporate Houses including Public Sector Enterprises and Bank have come forward to give us grant for conduct of the same. They include **ONGC, IOCL, HPCL, GAIL, IGL, PETRONET LNG LTD., EIL, CONCOR, RITES, ALIMCO, NBCFDC, NSFC, SAFEXPRESS, RAJDHANI FLOUR MILLS, VIBES, MARC and others.**



2. JHAKHE NANHI AAKHO MEIN (झांके नन्ही आँखों में)

Mahavir International recognises the need for early vision corection in the underprivileged children in absence of which other than suffering from health issues, their education also suffers. In earlier years MID Participated in Chacha Nehru Sehat Yojana of Delhi Government. Under this scheme we carried out comprehensives health check up and health counseling to students.

Mahavir International has re-launched the project in a slightly modified form under the tag “झांके नन्ही आँखों में” in this project Mahavir International is organizing camps in schools run by MCD and other NGO's to carry out prompt vision correction by provision of spectacles in a timely manner. During the **F Y 2023-24, 100** such camps were organised in resulting in check up of more that **12,598 students** and distribution of nearly **1,507 spectacles.**



3. SWABHLAMBAN (स्वावलम्बन)

Under the new initiative “**SWABHLAMBAN**” MID in its effort to empower the unemployed women in and around its centers is carrying out the following interventions:-



a. Sewing Training

MID has affiliated with **Singer** to provide up to six months of training in apparel production for underprivileged women living around its center at Nabi Karim. A total **76 women** have been trained till date. Further to encourage their entrepreneurial instincts, they have participated in fashion show as also in exhibition and sale of their products.



b. General Duty Assistants

Another such initiative has been the training of under privileged women as “General Duty Assistants”. The first course was started on 25th April, 2022 and till date **96 students** have been trained and certified by Apollo Mediskills. Almost all the trained beneficiaries have also been provided internship opportunities, with some carrying on in job.



c. Swasthya Saheli (स्वास्थ्य सहेली)

MID had taken-up the project SWASTHYA SAHELI for women where a trained GDA's are providing counseling on menstruation and women health issue as menstruation and breast feeding at our centres. Since it is start in March, 2023, nearly **19,759 women** have been benefitted with these services. We are also generating ABHA Card of patients who visit our centers, which will entitle them to avail benefits under PM Jan Arogya Yojna (PM-JAY). Till date nearly **800 ABHA** card have been generated.

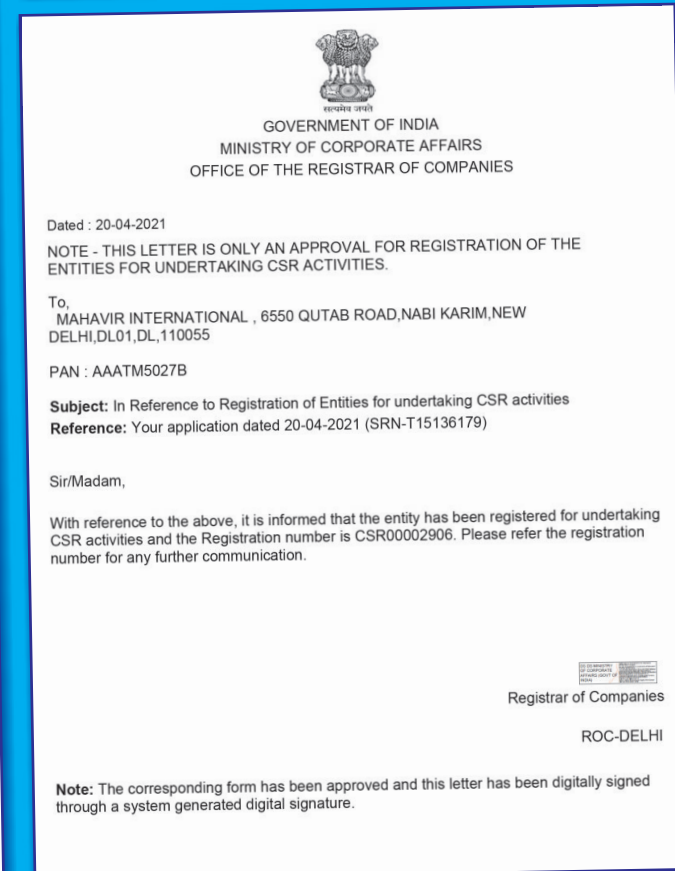
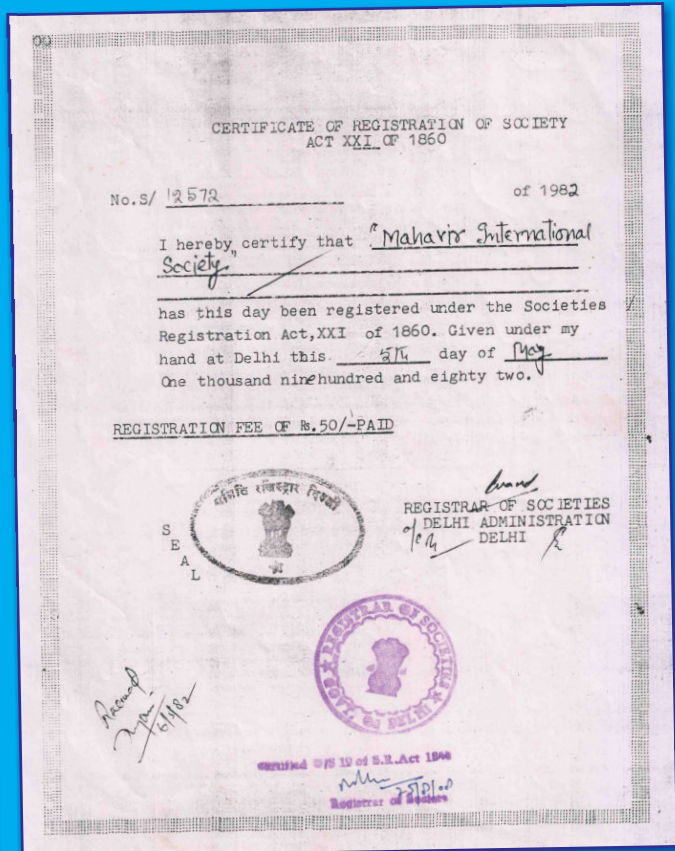

ANOTHER FEATHER IN THE CAP OF MID

1 JHAKHE NANHI AAKHO MEIN

Mahavir International underscores the significance of early vision care for underprivileged children, acknowledging that uncorrected eye issues can impact both their health and academic performance. Previously, the organization collaborated with the Delhi Government through the Chacha Nehru Sehat Yojana, providing health assessments and counseling for students. This effort has been reintroduced as Jhakhe Nanhi Aakho Mein (झाके नहीं आंखों में), focusing on conducting vision camps in partnership with MCD schools and NGOs to offer timely eye examinations and distribute spectacles. In the financial year 2023–24, 100 camps were organized, reaching over 12,598 students and distributing nearly 1,507 spectacles.

The project primarily aims to promote awareness about eye health and the early detection of vision problems among school children. By concentrating on the younger generation, it strives to identify refractive errors and other eye conditions at an initial stage, facilitating timely treatment and preventing further complications. It also seeks to educate students, teachers, and parents on the importance of regular eye check-ups while sharing practical advice on maintaining good eye health and preventing future issues.



2 KATHUWAS PROJECT

MID has made a foray into the sustainability initiatives by way of an ambitious project to inject rain water into parched land of Kathuwas in Alwar district.

A CSR project sanctioned by CONCOR, this initiative involves excavation of five ponds to capture the run off of rain water and injecting it through 200 ft deep bores drilled and inserted with perforated pipes.

MID is availing services of a Geologist consultant and Excavation expert for the project. Additionally, our latest member - Sh Ajay Singh IRSME who is water conservation domain expert is also closely monitoring the progress of project.

If all goes well mother earth will be richer by nearly a crore litres of water every year.



3 MID STRIDES AHEAD

New Initiative - जनित्रि कार्यशाला

जनित्रि कार्यशाला An INITIATIVE VIRA VISION UNIT OF MID, aiming to educate young expectant mothers about maternal and child health to minimize the risks of complications during pregnancy and childbirth. Total of 24 जनित्रि Workshops were held in the period January - March 2024 which covered the crucial topics, including prenatal care, proper nutrition and exercise during pregnancy, safe delivery practices, postpartum care, breastfeeding, birth spacing, and the advantages of small families. These sessions were proposed to take place at our health centers and community centers in close proximity to MID centers. Additionally, personalized consultations with ANC/GNM or General Duty Assistants were available for women seeking further information. Attendees of the workshops also received a maternity

kit and nutritional kit containing essential items to support the well-being of both the mother and her newborn. Each workshop were designed for **25-30 participants**, with an approximate duration of 90 minutes. The workshops were conducted by GNM/ANM professionals and assisted by a GDA. More than 700 expecting & lactating mothers and hence their families availed the all round benefits of this workshop.

VIRA VISION & THEIR ACTIVITIES

"Vira Vision" as the name suggests, comprises of a group of women members of MID working with compassion for all underprivileged in general and for women in particular. We adopt and implement some of the national projects initiated by MI Apex besides running our own local projects. There were three board meetings held of Vira Vision. Some of notable activities are enlisted below...

1. MOTHER & CHILD CARE under which we undertake distribution of baby kits for new born and sanitary napkins for mothers at government hospitals besides counseling the latter on cleanliness/hygiene.

2. SWABHLAMBHAN project, to vocationally empower women. This programme includes Sewing Classes being conducted in coordination with Singer. These training programmes are being conducted at our centres and till date 76 women especially youth have benefitted from these initiatives.

3. SWASTHYA SAHELI is another novel project to counsel women who visit our three centres on menstrual hygiene and breast feeding. Further, the counselling is done by women trained as General Duty Assistants as part of our Swavalamban project. Since its inception in March 2023, around 14,222 for Menstrual Hygiene & 5,537 for Breast feeding women have benefitted from this initiative till March 2024.

4. OTHER WELFARE ACTS which are carried out round the year such as Khushiyon ka Bazaar involving sale of cloths and other consumables against a token price, support to institutions caring for Alzheimer patients, financial aid for patients with limited means etc.

5. PROJECT JANETRI is our latest initiative to spread awareness of pre and post natal issues to pregnant women and new mothers through special workshops being planned at our centres. This includes distribution of baby kits and nutrients to the attendees. Total No. of 720 Pregnant and Lacting Mothers got benefitted through this initiative.

Another redeeming feature of these interventions is that the Viras personally contribute to support these impactfull projects and also interact one on one with the beneficiaries making them feel loved.

Vira Vision hopes to carry on with the above initiatives as also new ones with the spirit of 'Love All Serve All' in the coming times.
