

As we end the tenure of the Board of 2023-25, we can look back with satisfaction on our various achievements. First and foremost our spending on our various charitable activities exceeded Rs 8.5 crores in the recently concluded fiscal with nearly Rs. 2 crs being for upgrading our medical infrastructure. This should help us impart quality health care in the coming years!

However while quanta of finance has its significance, more important is its effective use. And on this front too, MID was not found wanting. We created a record of sorts by having as many as 556 community outreach programmes. Also, these were not one-dimensional but on multiple fronts. They included:

Doctor at Door Step – Mega Camps in Delhi NCR – 140

Doctor at Door Step – Mega Camps outside Delhi NCR – 152 **Jhanki Nanhi Aankhon Mein** – School eye and basic health camps – 96

Project Janitri – Health counselling of pregnant women & lactating mothers - 57

MID Anjuman – Weekly outreach clinics in slums of Delhi NCR - 111

Add to this the nearly 2000 cataract correction surgeries that we have conducted or facilitated and the approximately one lakh patients that have been treated in our centres, we have all reasons to feel justified as a holistic health care provider for the underprivileged.

Significantly, MID added a feather to its fulsome cap by taking on and completing a water recharge project in the rain parched district of Alwar at Kathuwas. The first rains have already proved beneficial with water level going up by scores of feet at a few locations!

In backdrop of the above, I feel very privileged and fortunate for once again being a part of the 2025-27 team, which will be carrying forward the various initiatives. Firstly, a fervent prayer to Almighty to continue to shower His grace on our organization so that we continue to do His work.

However, in return for this grace, we also need to step up our interventions. So a humble appeal to all members to please actively participate in our various interventions and more importantly, mingle with our beneficiaries. It needs no emphasis that compassion has to be the cornerstone of an organization inspired by the universal message of Love All Serve All espoused by Lord Mahavir. Secretary's Desk

The term for 2023 -25 has ended on 31st -March -2025 and once again Delhi centre has provided it's best by serving the poor and the needy to achieve the mission of "LOVEALL-SERVEALL"

The performance for these two years is as under:

Donation for the year 2023-2025 is Rs. 12.77 crore including foreign donations of Rs. 1.47 Crore. Sincerely thankful to our sponsors CONCOR, PETRONET, IOCL, GAIL, IGL, IRCTC, RAJDHANI BESAN GROUP, SAFEXPRESS PVT LTD, MANGALAM, INOXGFL, SSS FOUNDATION, Vibes Healthcare Ltd, Tamil Federation, Sh. Raj & Vandana Jain (USA), MARC Group, to name a few and our esteem members.

During the tenure 2023-25 we received a donation of **Rs. 221.45** as CAPEX donation. **Two Eeco Vans** and **One Trax Cruiser** were added to the infrastructure of MID under CSR initiative of PETRONET LNG LTD, CONCOR and IGL. **14 sets of Medical equipment's fromPETRONET and IRCTC for** use in **CAMPS & HOSPITALS, out of these 8 sets have** been handed over to Mahavir international Centres on PAN India basis namely **Indore, Gwalior, Jaipur, Hyderabad, Sumerpur Sheoganj, Jodhpur, Shree Mahavirji and Golakot** with a motive to provide the medical facilities on regular basis and for use in CAMPS for better services.

Mahavir international Delhi has to 2 fully equipped Eye Check up Vans to provide the facilities of EYE check up in the Vans itself. Other than this **IOCL** has provided us **Rs. 68 lac** for upgradation of our pathological lab at NABI KARIM and eye care equipment for hospital. **NMDFC** has generously provided a new Dental Clinic facility at Lala Aman Singh Jain Charitable Centre, Hauz Rani, Delhi. This initiative will enhance our healthcare services by providing quality dental care to the underprivileged community.

An MOU was signed with **TAMIL FEDERATION** of **Reunion island** and ANNAMALAI UNIVERSITY for **approximately Rs. One Crore** grant by **Tamil Federation**, **Reunion Islands** for interventions in Tamil Nadu including around 70 lakhs in districts of Cuddalore and Myladiturai (to be implemented by Annamali University). This mainly comprises of support for Installation of Medical Equipments in the **Govt. Primary Health Centre (PHCs)** and Infrastructure facilities for the government schools. Additionally **MI Chennai Metro and GK Jain Charitable School** located at Royapuram, Chennai also stand to gain by way of medical equipment and computer lab respectively.

MID is able to pursue it's main objective of providing primary health care services through all three hospitals at Nabi Karim, Hauzrani and Badarpur. 2,38,696 patients were checked in the OPD and 3,302 patients with cataract surgeries. 57 Weekly Anjuman Clinics were organized in which 6,057 patients were benefitted.

During the tenure of these two years 2023-2025 under the flagship programme 'Doctor at door step' MID organized 694 CAMPS. 417 CAMPS in DELHI NCR & 277 Camps pan India with the help of other center of Mahavir international. Under the flagship project of 'Doctor at door step', MID's target was to organize One Camp a day and I feel happy and proud to share that this year 2024-2025 we achieved this target of 'One Camp a day' by organizing total 388 CAMPS in a year. Delhi centre has organized 248 CAMPS (152 mega camps and 96 JNAM School camp) & 140 were organized by our other centres of Mahavir International. The partnership with other centres has given us strength to take up the projects on PAN India level.

I am highly thankful to MI Jodhabai Jodhpur, MI Greater Jaipur, MI SumerpurSheoganj, MI Gwalior, MI Indore, MI Ludhiana, MI Malerkotla, MI Ambala City, MI Raipur Main, MI Nagpur, MI Atulyanari (Hyderabad), MI Sambhajinagar(Aurangabad), MI Vashi Navi Mumbai, MI Chittorgarh for their support and cooperation.

Organizing 248 camps in Delhi & NCR required a lot of planning, dedication, and commitment. I sincerely congratulate all my staff members for achieving the target & salute their dedication, commitment, loyalty to MID.

MID is actively running Project Janitri across its health centers to educate young girls on menstrual hygiene and support young mothers in breast feeding. This community outreach initiative aims to enhance maternal and child health, reducing pregnancy and childbirth complications. Workshops cover menstrual hygiene, sanitary napkin usage, prenatal care, nutrition, safe delivery, postpartum care, breast feeding, birth spacing, and the benefits of a small family. In 2023-24, BI World facilitated 24 Janitri workshops, while in 2024-25, CONCOR has supported with 30 workshops, further strengthening our efforts in community health education.

New project of **Swastha Saheli** for **medical guidance** in the field of **Breast feeding** and other related issues was also launched and more than **two lac women** were educated.

A Nursing assistants programme called **GDA**, was also started to empower the unemployed youth. Programme is certified by Apollo Hospital and **47** youth has been successfully achieved the certificates. Other than the regular hospital, MID also started One Project on sewing training under initiative **SWAVLAMBAN** project for WOMEN EMPOWERMENT INITIATIVE of MI Apex under the wings of Vira vision was at Rajdhani Charitable Eye and Medical centre Nabi Karim and 57 students successfully passed.

Other than medical acilities, MID has ventured in a new field in environmental betterment in partnership of CONCOR. A project of water project recharge had been successfully completed in **CONCOR terminal at KHATUWAS** Rajasthan. This will able to increase the ground water level by channelling the rain water available. The cost of this project was 95 lacs.

As the Treasurer of Mahavir International, Delhi, I am pleased to present a summary of our financial performance for the year ending March 31st. This year, we navigated our responsibilities with prudence and commitment, ensuring that every rupee entrusted to us was used with care and purpose. The impact of our collective efforts is eloquently reflected in the Secretary's message.

Financial Overview

Income: We received aprox. RS.1.6 Cr for CAPEX donations, Rs.1.46 Cr from 3 hospitals donations and aprox Rs. 4 Cr for our different projects—reflecting the continued trust and support of our compassionate community.

Expenditure: Our total expenses amounted to Rs.6.7 Cr. The majority of this was allocated to our flagship project "Doctor at Doorstep", along with other program implementations, staff salaries, and the operational costs of our three hospitals.

From the donations received under Capex head, expenditure involved asset investments like hospital equipment, office furniture & fixtures, computers and ambulance.

Financial Health: We continue to maintain a strong and stable financial position, with a healthy balance sheet and sufficient reserves to support our ongoing endeavors.

Key Achievements: We met and surpassed our set targets.

Several new programs were successfully launched.

Our outreach expanded significantly—touching more lives (276305) through camps, hospitals, and new initiatives.

We established meaningful collaborations with other Mahavir International centres to expand our impact across India.

We partnered with other NGOs to strengthen our joint mission of community service.

Looking Ahead: We remain committed to financial responsibility and sustainability. Our future strategy focuses on diversifying funding sources, strengthening our programs, and expanding our reach to serve even more beneficiaries.

Gratitude: I am honored and humbled to serve under the leadership of our visionary and quick-witted Chairman, Sh. K. Narayan, who entrusted me with this role. I look forward to continuing our collective journey toward greater impact, alongside our Executive leadership team.

BOARD MEETING

A meeting of the Board of Directors of Mahavir International Delhi was convened on 15th February 2025 at D-5, Hauz Khas, New Delhi-110016.

The meeting commenced with the Prayer 'Meri Bhawna.'

The following agenda items were discussed in sequence:

- 1. Confirmation of the Minutes of the last Board Meeting held on 13th December 2024, after reviewing the Action Taken Report.
- 2. Presentation of the nine-month performance and accounts: The performance for the period from 1st April 2024 to 31st December 2024 was presented by Smt. Abha Jain, Hon. Treasurer.
 - (a) Seven 7 new members were added during the period from April to December 2024.
 - (b) Hospital Performance was reviewed.
- **3.** Camp Performance: A total of 234 camps were organized in the half-year ending December 2024, compared to 172 camps during the same period in the previous year. The board was informed that MID has set a target of organizing 400 camps by the end of the financial year.
- **4.** Laboratory Services: The outsourcing of lab services has resulted in reducing the deficit by ₹1.50 lakh per month. Additionally, there has been a 19% increase in patient footfall at the lab.
- **5. Income & Expenditure Account:** Receipts have increased by 41% compared to the same period of the previous year, attributed to the rise in the number of camps and the initiation of three to four new projects.
- **6.** Any other matters with the permission of the Chair.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the Chair.


