Warm greeting to all on behalf of the entire team of MID management and staff

The last few months has indeed seen a qualitative shift in our interventions as we move from being a curative health organization to a preventive one. Needless to say Doctor at Doorstep - our pioneering and flagship intervention was designed for the purpose of taking the doctors and paramedics to the multitude of under-served for whom visiting a quality Doctor is either prohibitively expensive or out of their reach - due to the time and inconvenience involved. Building up on the same we have intensified the School camps outreach - Jhanke Nanhi Aankhom Mein. Additionally we have started the Anjuman clinics - which are held on a weekly basis in three locations and fortnightly basis on two other locations wherein Doctor, Optometrist, Lab Technician and health counsellor help detect and address basic health and eye related issues. These clinics have become very popular with around 50 consultations happening on each occasion.

But going even further into the space of nutritional and emotional well-being, we have started Janitiri and Asha Kiran workshops. The first isfor counselling pregnant women & lactating mothers on nutrition and healthy lifestyle, The second (Asha Kiran) is for equipping community workers with basic counselling skills so that they can not only be the first intervention point for the underprivileged - especially women in distress due to domestic abuse & alcoholism, but also learn about self-care given their exposure to such distressing situations. Both these programmes as their name suggests are women centric and aim to empower women to take good care of themselves and their families. The fact that these programmes are significant for equipping the underprivileged to come out of mistaken beliefs and hence poverty, has got endorsed by the fact that various Corporate donors are opting to sponsor these programmes.

At the same time our eye and health centres continue to be given all possible support possible. Thanks to CSR support from PSUs we have installed Phaco -mulsification machines, YAG laser, OCT, A Scan etc in our centres, which help detect and attend to complications in the eyes at costs much lower than the prevailing market rates. We are also constantly reviewing the requirements of qualified Doctors and bringing more into our fold, duly keeping in mind our financial constraints. Recently, thanks to support of Sanjivini Society of Mental Health, we have been able to commence a psychiatry clinic in our Hauz Rani centre which is attended by a psychiatrist on a fortnightly basis.

We are accordingly hopeful that MID will play a rightful role in both curative and preventive medicare in the years to come.

Last but not the least, we look forward to the moral, financial and logistical support from our members, as always, so that we can enhance the quality, quantity and variety of our interventions to benefit those in distress.
















### **COHESIVE INTERFACE**

To review the recent MI Apex election guidelines and note variances with MID's registered Rules and Regulations; to be discussed further in the upcoming AGM.


#### 6. Annual General Meeting

As Mahavir International continues its journey of "Service to Sight", collaborations like these stand as pillars of meaningful change and social impact.










### **HEALTH TALK SHOW** by Mahavir International Delhi
















### **SABKO BHOJAN**
