ABOUT US

Mahavir International Delhi is a leading non-religious, not-for-profit, social service organisation, primarily working in the sphere of health care with special emphasis on **eye care, cataract operations** and **eye donations** since 1979, through three **well equipped medical centres** located at **Nabi Karim, Hauz Rani and Badarpur**.

In addition, we have five fully equipped mobile units to carry out community outreach in Delhi NCR under our flagship project “**DOCTOR AT DOOR STEP**”. Over the years more than **60 lakhs** patients have benefited from our services. We have till date organised more than **4,200** free Eye & Health checkup camps, more than **270 Jhanke Nanhi Ankho Mein (School camp)**, nearly **230 clinics**, nearly **100 Janitri Workshops** and performed nearly **36,000 cataract operations**. We have also motivated **323** families to donate eyes of loved ones after death thereby facilitating **646** blind persons to see and enjoy the beauty of this wonderful world.

Apart from this, under the **Project Swavalamban**, **193 women** have been imparted training of apparel stitching and **181 students** have been imparted **General Duty Assistant (GDA)** training over the past two years. **70 students** of Classes VI to IX are being given **tuition classes** at nominal cost. More than **37,000 women** have been counselled on menstrual hygiene and breast feeding in our three centres under our latest initiative “**Swasthya Saheli**”.

Since 2024, MID has expanded its horizons into environmental sustainability also, one project already completed and another going to be taken up soon.

MID has a membership of **416** eminent persons comprising of retired and serving senior bureaucrats, professionals, industrialists, businessmen, social workers and philanthropists. A detailed list of persons at the helm of affairs of MID (for the term 2025-27) is given in the following pages. All these members are working selflessly without any political, religious or pecuniary motive.

We are registered with the **Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Govt. of India, vide Reg. No-CSR00002906**, with **NITI Aayog Vide Reg. No-DL2017/0152633**, and registered for **FCRA** under the **Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt of India, for receiving Foreign Donations**. This noble initiative has been made possible with the major support of medical equipments by **Indian Railway Catering & Tourism Corporation (IRCTC)**, under their CSR initiative, exemplifying the power of collaborative philanthropy.

Also, regular eye checking facility was not there.

Chandrawali Siddhomal Jain Hospital**, ensuring that critical eye care services are accessible at the patients' doorstep. Medical equipments worth ₹52 lakh were procured through the generous support of public sector enterprises such as IRCTC, IGL, and Petronet LNG Ltd.

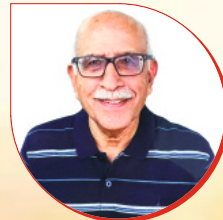
